Disciplinary Action

To keep our club awesome, we follow a simple three-strike system for behavior that doesn't meet our high standards.

1. Strike One and Two: A Heads-Up!

- If an athlete shows negative behavior, like unkind remarks or a bad attitude towards coaches and peers, it's a strike. Our directors and coaches will keep parents in the loop with every warning. We believe in giving chances to improve and shine!

2. Strike Three: Time to Reflect

- Three strikes? It's time for a little break from classes or competitions. We'll arrange a meeting with parents or guardians to chat about it.

It's not just about the rules; it's about understanding, growing, and getting back on track.

1. Safety and Respect: Our Top Priority

- We're serious about keeping our club safe and respectful. In rare cases, if behavior is threatening or seriously out of line, our directors have the right to make tough calls. This could mean saying goodbye to athletes or parents who don't align with our code of conduct.



Competition Information

IMPORTANT

Teams will participate in 3 to 5 competitions per season, depending on the team's specific schedule. All competitions are compulsory, and participation is critical for both individual and team success.

Training sessions two weeks before and directly after a competition are of the utmost importance and are considered mandatory. If your athlete is absent without a medical certificate, they will be unable to compete regardless of whether you have paid.

These sessions are vital for team cohesion, preparation, and post-event review. Missing these sessions is not acceptable under any circumstances, as they are critical for ensuring the team's readiness and progress.

NO JEWELLERY IS PERMITTED

No jewellery is permitted to be worn during training. This is a safety hazard for all athletes. Earrings **MUST** be taken out, this is not negotiable.

DO NOT GET PIERCING DURING THE SEASON

Even if the piercing is new you will be told to **TAKE IT OUT** prior to class. This includes:

- Earrings
- Nose
- Belly
- Tongue
- Eyebrow

You will be asked to remove them, no one likes to be scratched or stabbed during stunting!!!



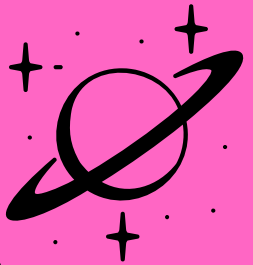
Competition Uniforms



Competition uniform is **COMPULSORY** and **NOT** included in training fees. A 50% uniform deposit needs to be paid by week 4 of term 1 to ensure that they can be ordered and received in time for the comp season.

The uniform cost is detailed below and inclusions:

Cheer Uniforms

Costumes are sourced and invoiced accordingly. Approximately \$150

Pom Teams

Some teams will require a costume for the season for Pom. Each team will be advised at the beginning of term 1 if a costume is needed.

Teams not costumed will require:

- Competition Cheer uniform

All Pom athletes will require:

- Jazz shoes
- POMS (additional \$50)
- Team Bow (additional cost)



Attendance

As this is a **team sport**, the success of the team is based on **all** athletes attending all sessions and training hard. We understand that athletes get sick or life happens, all we ask is that it is communicated so we can effectively manage the class structure. Please call or text Annemarie or Zoe on the numbers provided.

Please note – **it is at the Directors discretion to remove an athlete from a competition due to poor attendance.** Safety is paramount in this sport and if even momentarily safety can be questioned, we reserve the right to remove an athlete. Missing training prior to competitions throws the entire vibe out for the team. If your athlete does another sport that clashes with training, we will require said athlete to move into a team that allows them to attend **ALL** scheduled training sessions. This may mean competing a team below their skill level, unless otherwise discussed and agreed.

IMPORTANT: If an athlete misses the training prior to any competition it is at the directors discretion to **not allow the athlete to compete, regardless of money paid.** Athletes are expected to attend training sessions following competitions, this is where we go through score sheets and advise of changes to routines, it is not acceptable to miss training after a competition without a medical certificate or prior discussion.

Tuition



Fees are charged per school term regardless of athlete attendance. These are calculated on yearly tuition and then divided by 4 terms for convenience.

Payment for fees is due by the end of week 1 of every term if not paying by direct debit. Failure to make payment will result in athletes being excluded from training. **Payment arrangements MUST BE IN WRITING, please message the facebook page.**

NOTE:

- Those paying via direct debit, should payments bounce, the costs outlined by EZIDEBIT will be added to your account.
- Failure to make payment for Uniforms could result in the athlete not getting their uniform in time for the season.
- Failure to make payment for Competition Entries at the advised times will result in athletes NOT competing in that competition.

We have various payment options available. Ezidebit for training fees (weekly, fortnightly, monthly or termly), EFTPOS, cash or direct transfer for convenience.
